Hall of Fame Classic Sled Roundup May 24th, 2015

The Bo-Boen Snowmobile Club was again invited to participate in the Snowmobile Hall of Fame's Annual Classic Sled Roundup. This year our members volunteered their labor and their time by participation in the food kitchen on Memorial Day week-end. Our Bo-Boen crew comprised of grillers, food preps, servers, and cashiers worked their tails off providing service and food to the events participants. Even though the event did not officially begin until 8 AM, we were there and open for business by 6 AM serving coffee and donuts to the other vendors as they set up their booths, tents, and equipment. Each year this event gets bigger and bigger, according to the Hall of Fame, and that is also evident in the amount of food that we have to prepare. All together we served over 900 customers during the day.

Our total profit for the club was \$2,282.00 after all expenses. This money will be put in the club's general fund, and will aid in keeping your snowmobile trails the best in the State of Wisconsin again next snowmobile season. Because of our hard work, long hours and fantastic success, we were able to share some of the proceeds with our event hosts, by giving them a check in the amount of \$912.00 made out to the Snowmobile Hall of Fame, for allowing us to be there and participate. Its successful events such as these, along with the BIG hearts of our volunteers, that make the results of our projects successful, and aid in keeping our club expenses supported. This will help your club to maintain the dues at our current levels. Without our club's GREAT volunteers we could not provide these services, and would have to come up with additional support funding sources elsewhere. Keep in mind that the State of Wisconsin only pays for groomed trails on State or County lands. Private land grooming is the sole responsibility of the club, and these extra funds provide some relief towards that tremendous effort.

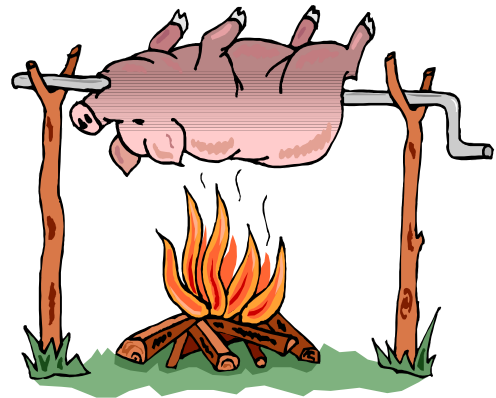

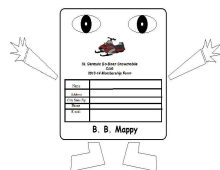

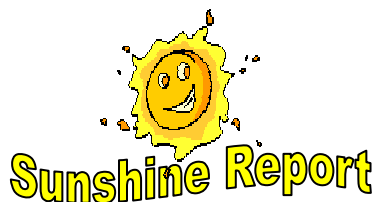
